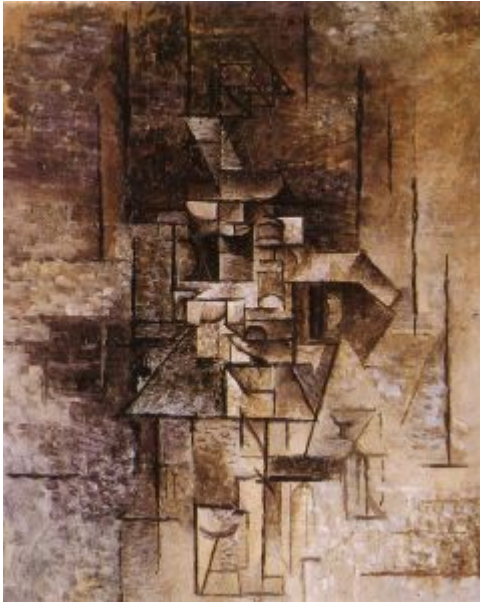

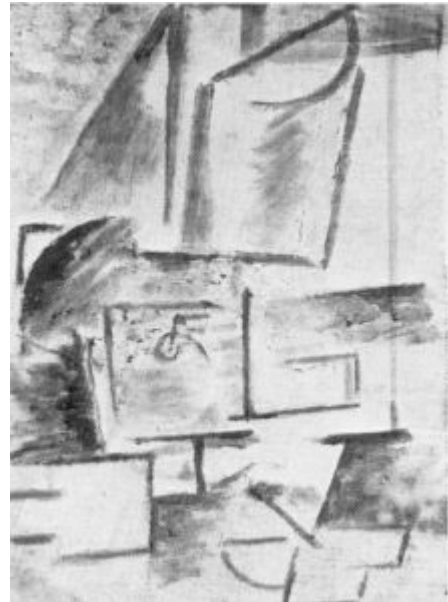

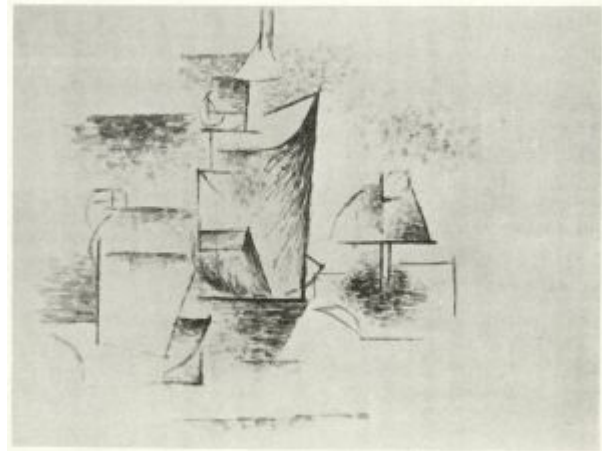

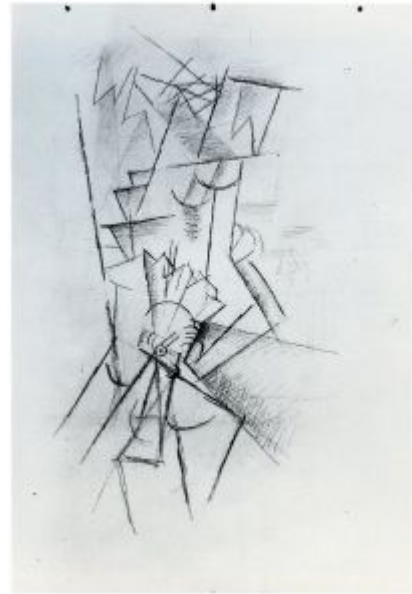

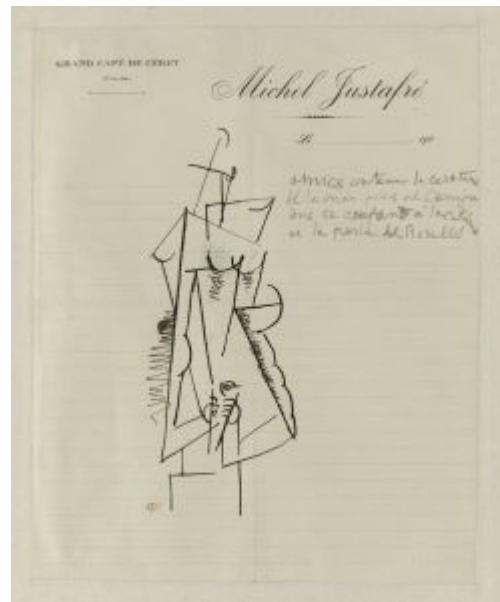

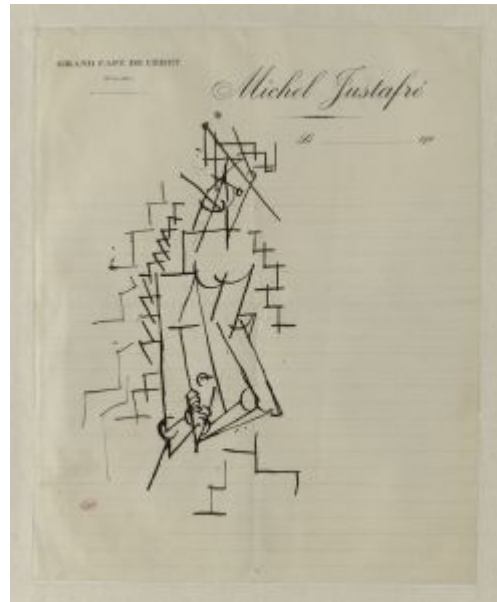

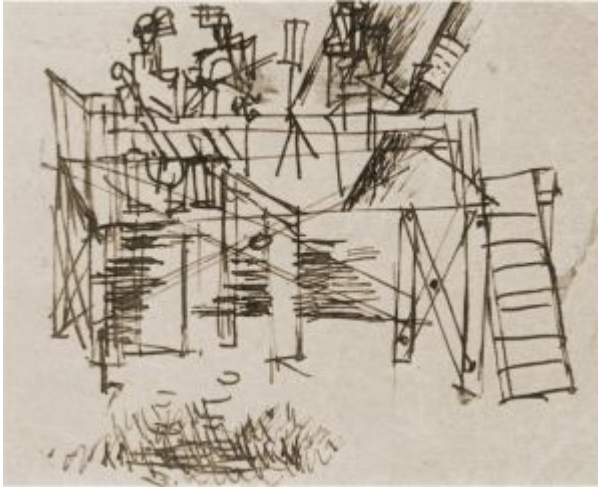

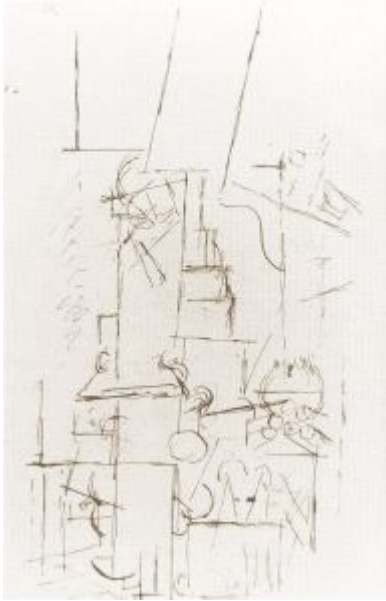

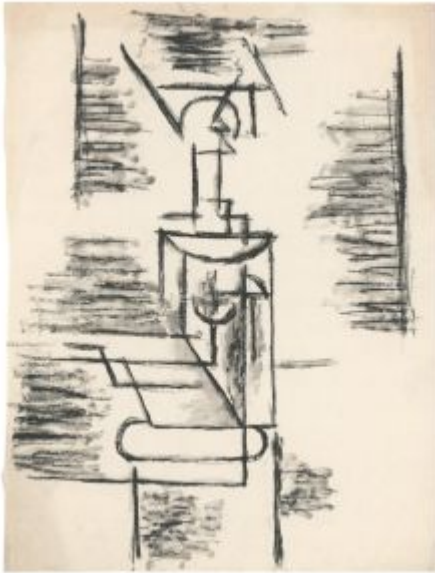

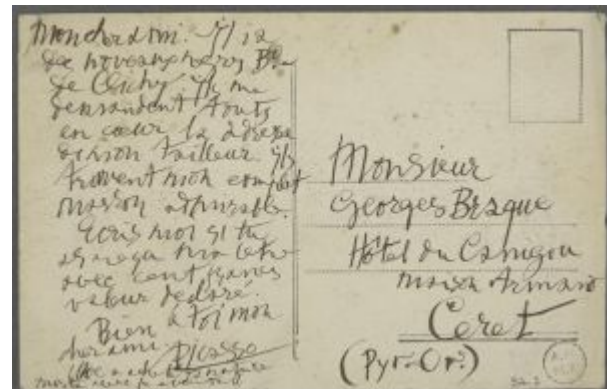

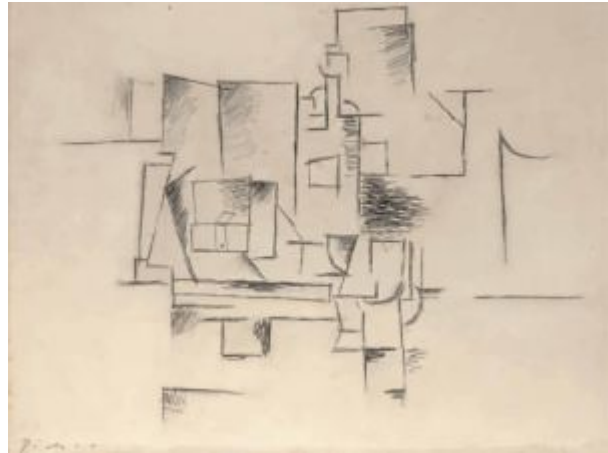


Femme assise à la guitare (IV). Paris. 1911~1912
