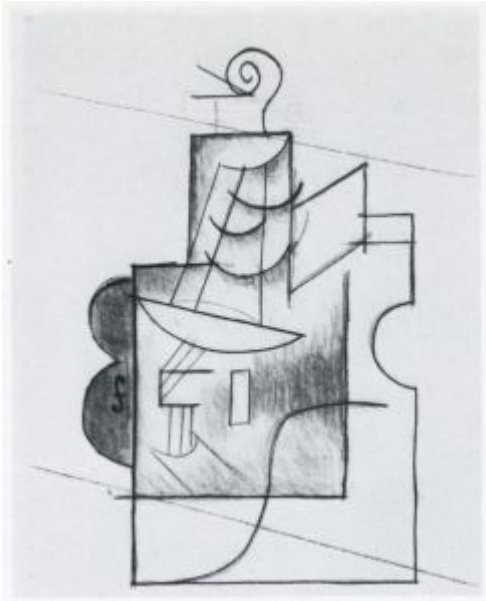

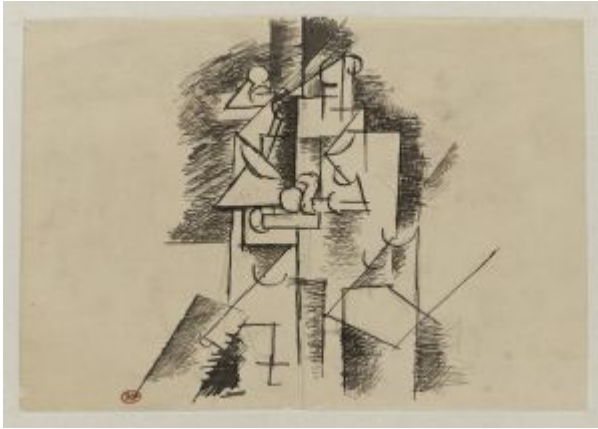

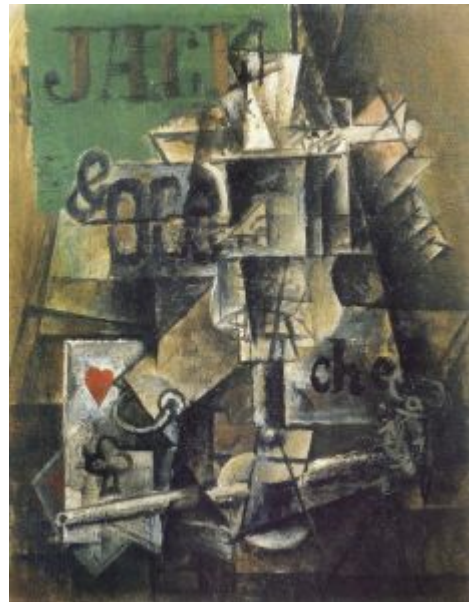

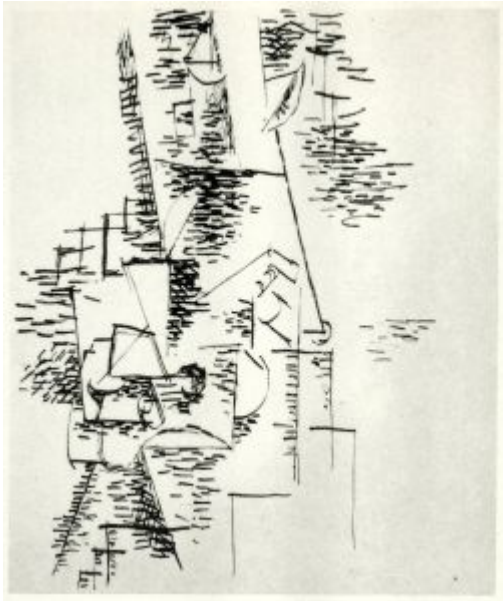

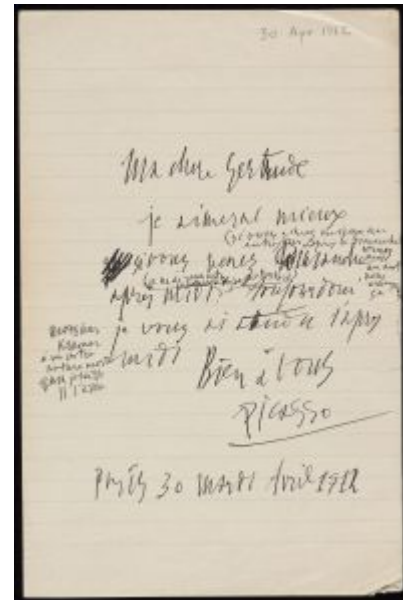

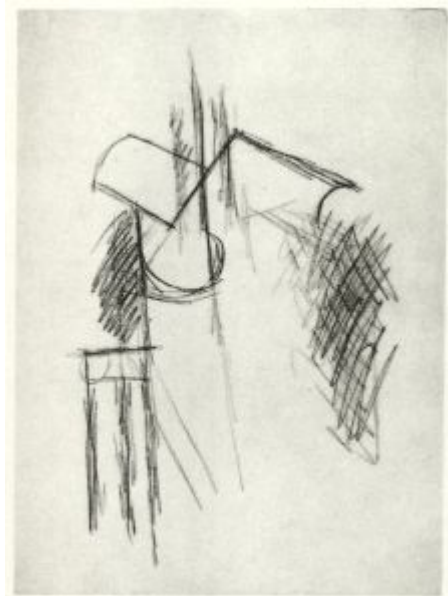


Projet pour une sculpture en bois: tête. Paris. [Fall]/1912.

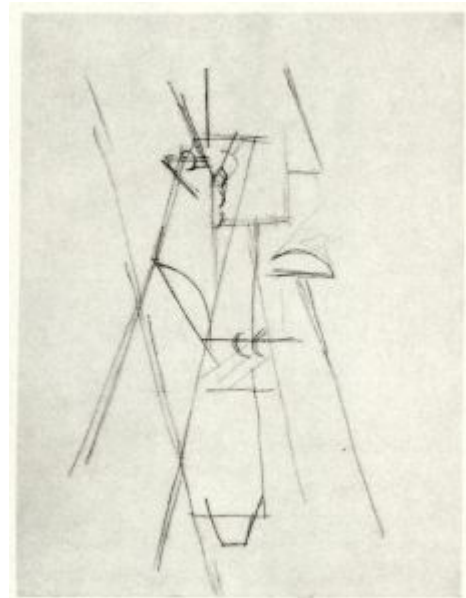

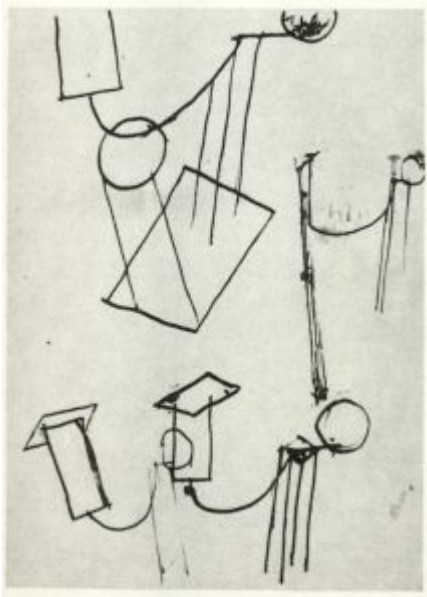

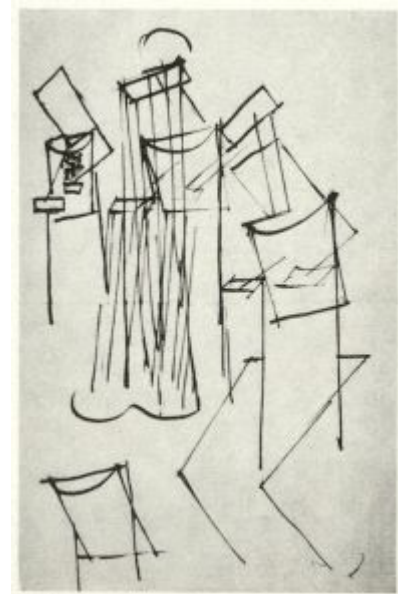


Projet pour une sculpture en bois: détail. Paris. [Fall]/1912.

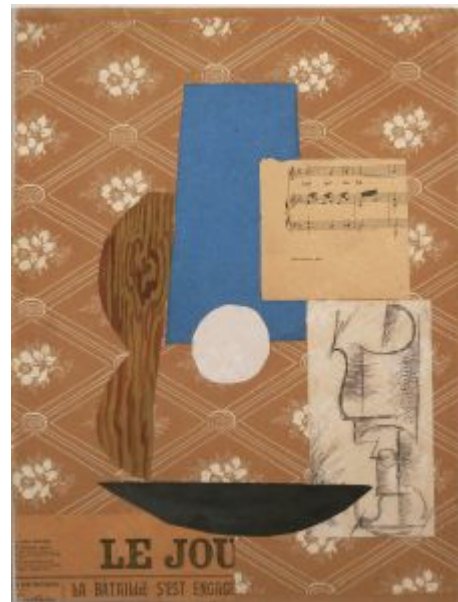

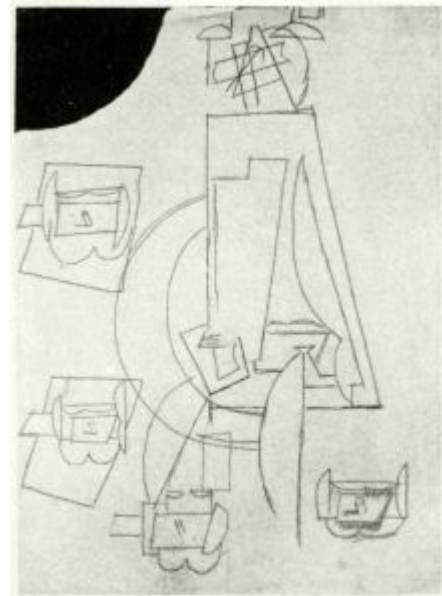
