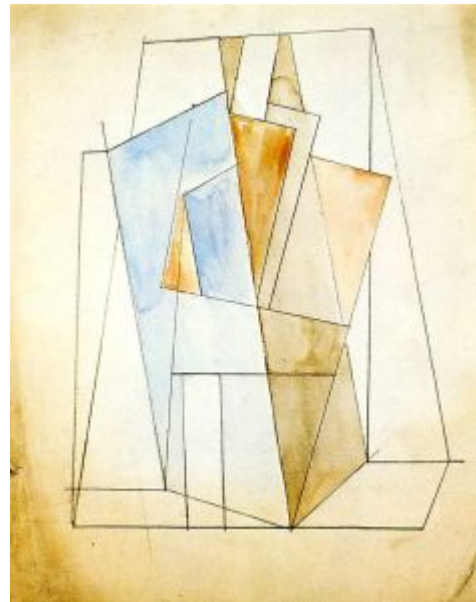

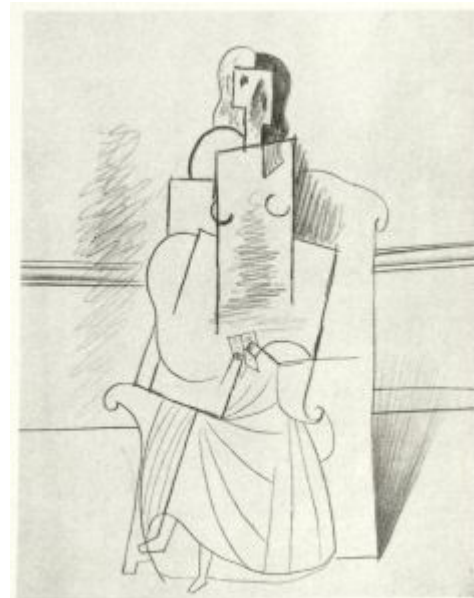


Femme assise dans un fauteuil. Paris. [Early]/1916. Pencil on paper. 27,3 x 21 cm. The Picasso Estate.

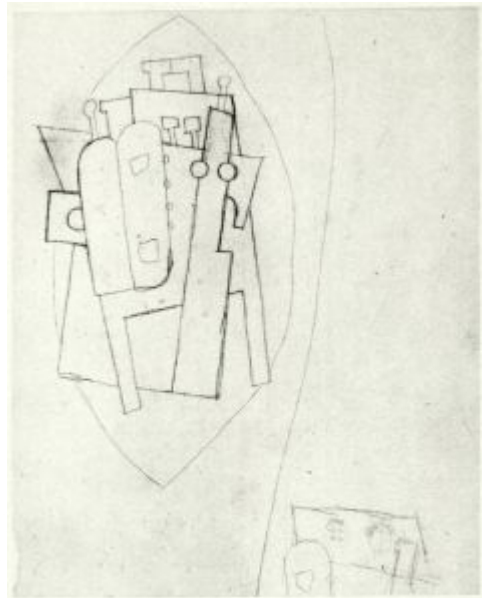

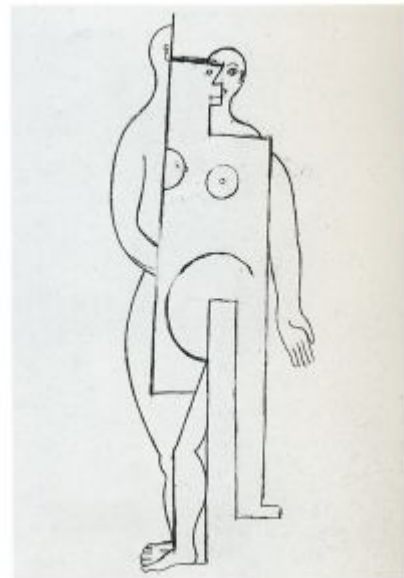

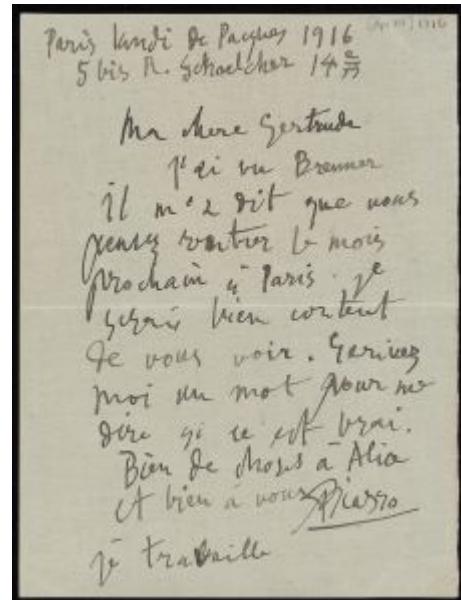

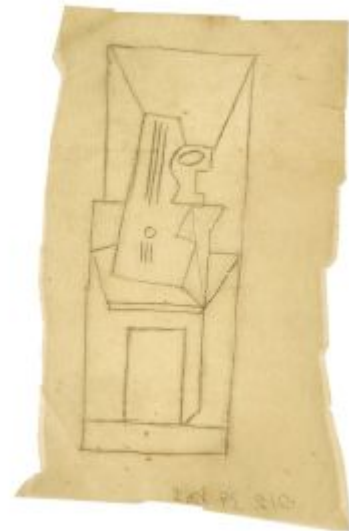


Arlequin à la batte. Paris. Fall/1916. Lead pencil on paper. 25 x 17,5 cm. The Picasso Estate.

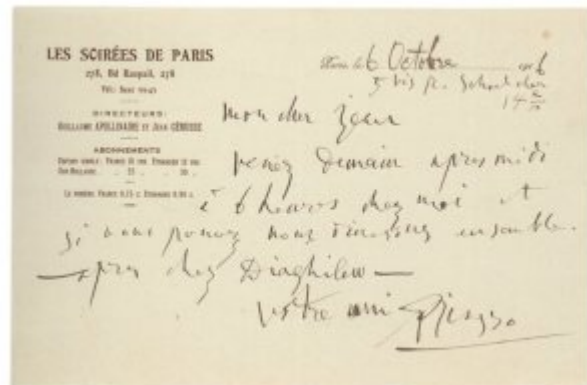


Jeune arlequin vu de gauche. Montrouge.

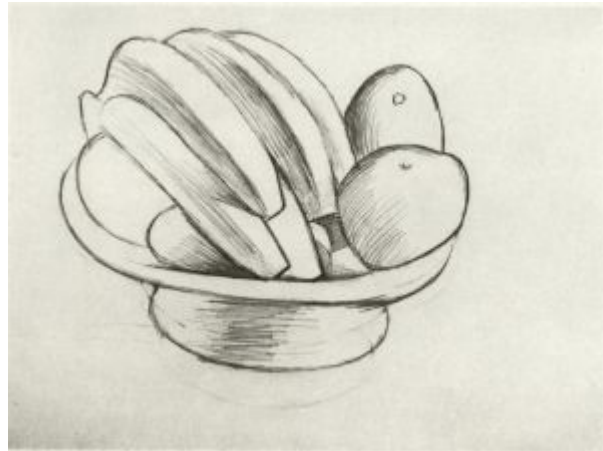


Compotier avec fruits. Montrouge.

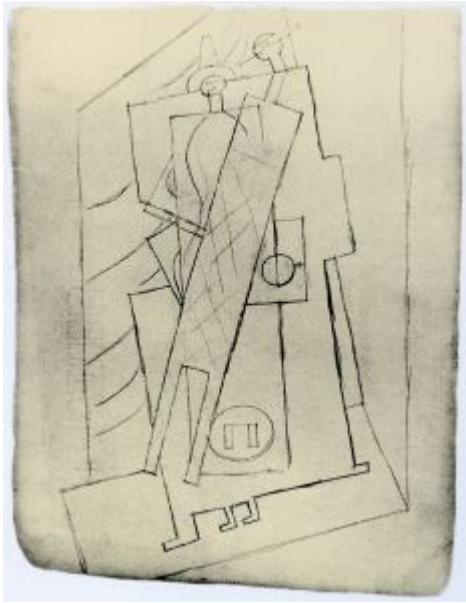

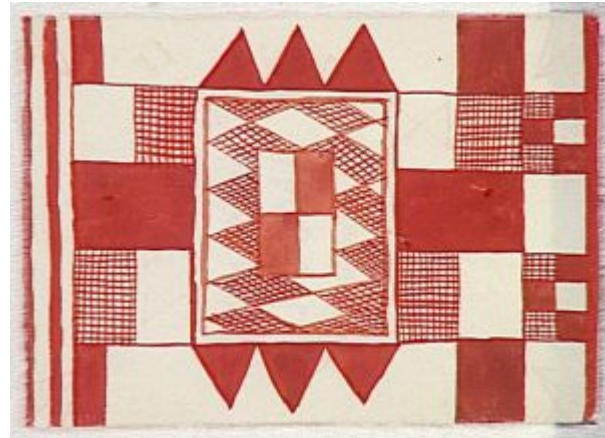

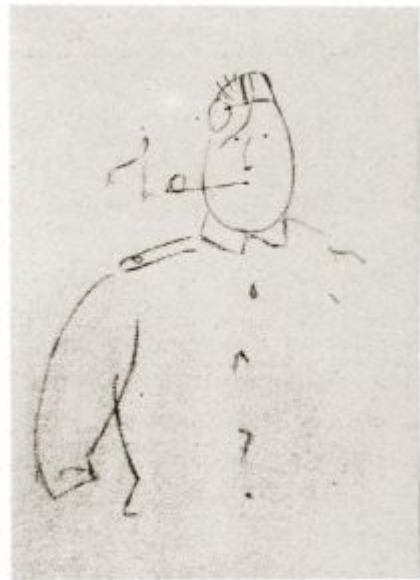

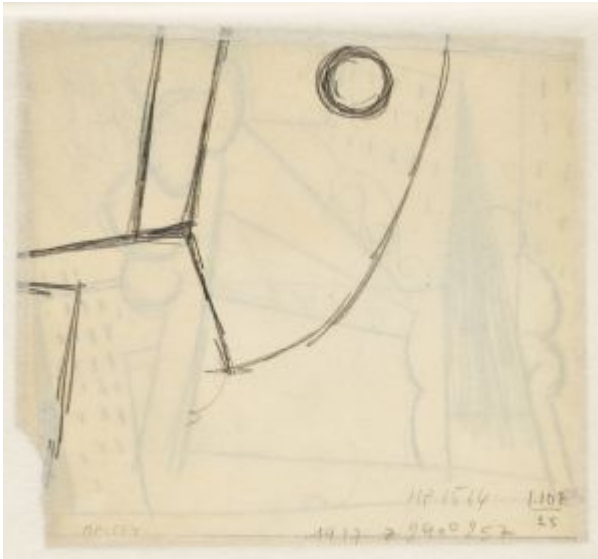

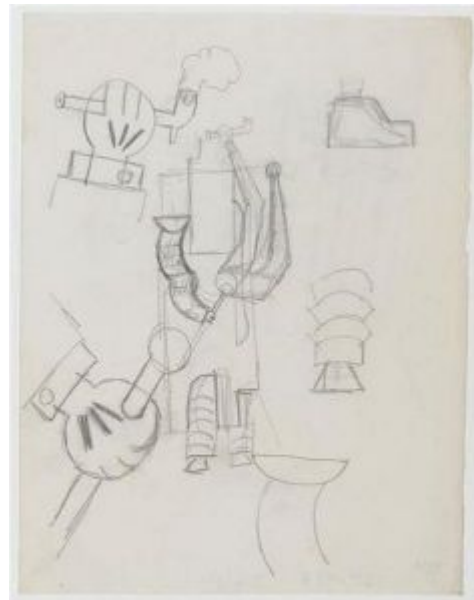

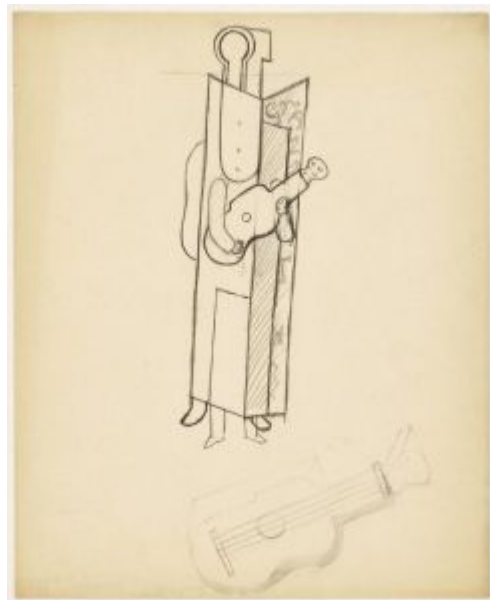

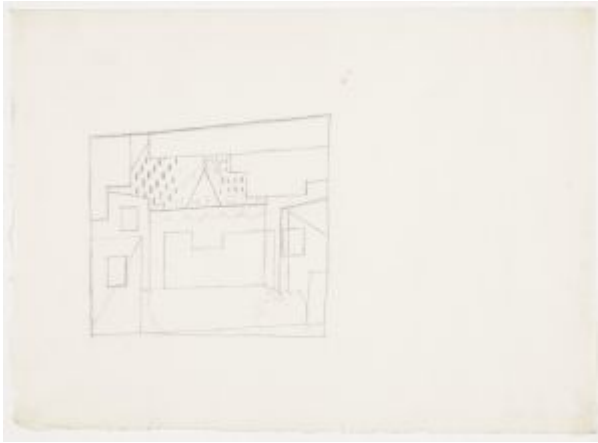
